
## MARTINO BITTI

ypically for Bitti's earlier sonatas, the Sonata in C minor belonging to the London group features four movements in the standard configuration for chamber sonatas of the time: a prelude-like slow opening movement followed by three further movements of either implicit or explicit dance character. This sonata features a particularly eloquent third movement having the character of a *sarabande*, while the concluding giga-like movement exhibits irrepressible verve.
