

he Medley Concerto by Richard Mudge, an eighteenth-century English clergyman and composer, belongs within the tradition of Handel and Geminiani, Scored for a concerto grosso string ensemble plus two horns in D, which have remarkably adventurous and prominent parts, it successfully combines dance variation form with baroque concerto structure, and has a central fugal movement based on 'The Highlanders March'. This good-humoured, sometimes riotous, piece, would make the perfect conclusion to a concert.
