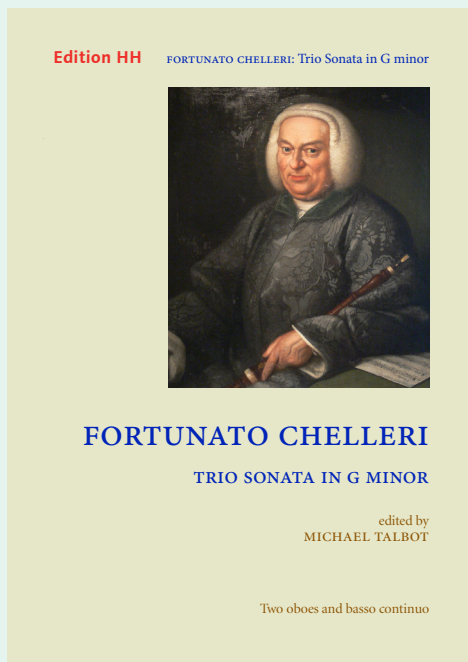


FORTUNATO CHELLERI

Fortunato Chelleri (c.1690–1757) was a prominent member of the large diaspora of Italian musicians who played a leading role in northern European musical life in the eighteenth century. This delightful piece, a useful addition to the trio sonata repertoire for two oboes and continuo, offers a fitting introduction to Chelleri’s captivating style, which mixes Italian and German elements.

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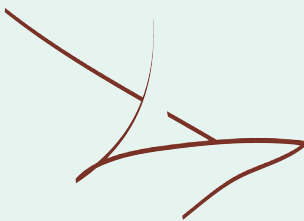
