It consists of three contrasting movements: a moderately paced first movement which shifts in character towards the end; a meditative slow, middle movement, and a folksy, brisk finale.

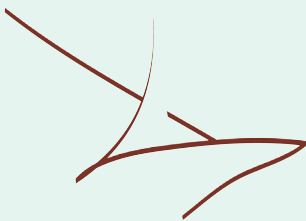
