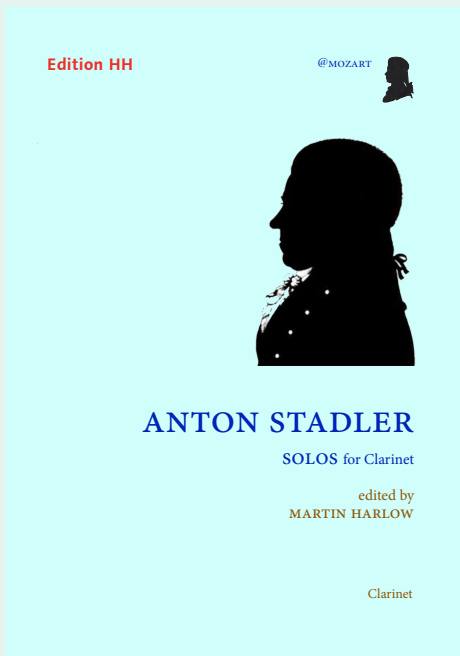

Anton Stadler's duos for clarinet are collected into a single volume for the first time and include hitherto unpublished music. *Six Duettinos* afford the opportunity for clarinetists to perform a range of short movements in different tempos and styles, with the distinction between first and second clarinet writing being consistently maintained. The six *Duo Concertantes* are more democratic in their treatment of the two instruments, with equal distribution of solos and accompaniments. These duos offer a window onto the instrumental idioms and musical language of Mozart's friend and clarinetist
